CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER AND FOSTER RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-5363, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 5.02 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 51155. The date of priority is OCTOBER 16, 1990. This right is limited to 0.06 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

FOSTER RESERVOIR - NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.; AND

SOUTH SANTIAM RIVER - SE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 57, SECTION 20, TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 420 FEET NORTH AND 1465 FEET EAST FROM SW CORNER SECTION 20.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

The water user shall comply with the terms and conditions of contract no. 1-07-10-W0819 dated December 7, 1990, between the right holder and Bureau of Reclamation, or a satisfactory replacement thereof, a copy of which is on file with the Water Resources Department.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


TOWNSHIP 12 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.
