## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ANDY G. KEESECKER 12987 GILMOUR ROAD S JEFFERSON, OREGON 97352

confirms the right to store the waters of AN UNNAMED INTERMITTENT STREAM, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, in A RESERVOIR, for WILDLIFE.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-12008. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 7, 1996. The amount of water entitled to be appropriated for storage during the period of November 1 through June 30 of each year under this right is not more than 7.0 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4
AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 57 AND 43
SECTION 18
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the water user to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the water user to install a meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.
- B. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The water user may be required in the future to install, maintain, and operate fish screening and bypass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of a fully functional conduit/gate assembly having a minimum diameter of 8 inches.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
