CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GENE UNDERHILL
82541 DUFER VALLEY ROAD
DUFER, OREGON 97021

confirms the right to use the waters of FIFTEENMILE CREEK, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.5 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for WASCO COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 7, at Page 406. The date of priority is 1856.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited one acre foot per acre during any 30 day period up to July 1st and 3/4 acre foot per acre during any 30 day period thereafter not to exceed 3.0 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year. The rate of flow shall not exceed one-fortieth cubic foot per second per acre after July 1st.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 33, T 1 S, R 13 E, W.M.; 2480 FEET NORTH AND 2250 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 33.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 6 (NE 1/4 SE 1/4) 3.0 ACRES
LOT 5 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4) 7.5 ACRES
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 13 EAST, W.M.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable devise for measuring and recording he quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 29, 1990, and along with Certificate 64753, supersedes Certificate 49488, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
