CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MAY SCHULTZ
GATEWAY, OREGON 97220

confirms the right to use the waters of TROUT CREEK, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 9.92 ACRES, DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USE.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JEFFERSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 4, at Page 57. The date of priority is 1880.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.5 ACRE FEET PER ACRE DURING ANY 30 DAYS OR 6 ACRE FEET DURING ANY IRRIGATION SEASON CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

WEST BOLTER DITCH.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE~~X~~ NE~~X~~ 3.82 ACRES
NE~~X~~ SE~~X~~ 6.10 ACRES
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 9 SOUTH, RANGE 15 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 2257, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 19 1999, approving Transfer Application 6851.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
