CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GARY WILDE 18048 MIDDLE ROCK CREEK LANE ARLINGTON, OREGON 97812

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the ROCK CREEK BASIN for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 7.6 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 47.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-11825. The date of priority is MARCH 14, 1984. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.68 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 3, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 21 EAST, W.M.; 4480 FEET SOUTH AND 2322 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. The portion of this right for supplemental irrigation is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the water user shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This right is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
