CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAN AND/OR JOHN KOVTYNOVICH
1595 SKYLINE PARK LOOP
EUGENE, OREGON 97405

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of AMAZON CREEK, for MAINTENANCE OF A NATURAL POND FOR FISH CULTURE.

This right was perfected under Permit 51524. The date of priority is JUNE 30, 1988. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.036 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.;
860 FEET SOUTH AND 813 FEET EAST FROM THE W 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 16
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.


The water user shall maintain a device at the point of diversion capable of measuring and regulating the quantity of water diverted.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
