CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

BLACK BUTTE RANCH ASSOCIATION PO BOX 8000 BLACK BUTTE RANCH, OREGON 97759

confirms the right to use the waters of BLACK BUTTE RANCH SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT, a tributary of INDIAN FORD CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 55.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44005. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 2, 1979. This right is limited to 0.83 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 9, T 14 S, R 9 E, W.M.; 200 FEET SOUTH AND 240 FEET EAST FROM THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 29.0 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 0.2 ACRE
SECTION 9

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 10.2 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 9.3 ACRES

TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH RANGE 9 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
