## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DEL REED BERGESON 384 RIPPLE ROAD ONTARIO, OREGON 97914 FRED HAUN 190 EAST MAIN WEISER, IDAHO 83672

confirms the right to use the waters of SNAKE RIVER, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 15.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 608. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 20, 1911. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.2 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

BERGESON DIVERSION - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W.M.; 270 FEET NORTH AND 445 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 21; AND

HAUN DIVERSION - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 47 EAST, W.M.; 567 FEET SOUTH AND 2638 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

When required by the Department, the water users shall install and maintain head gates, in-line flow meters, weirs, or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted, The type and plans of the head gates and measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in PLACE OF USE AND POINTS OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 17, 1997, and together with Certificate 74527, supersedes Certificate 1042, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
