CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the water of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 14.8 ACRES.

The right was perfected under Permit No. 27858 and the date of priority is FEBRUARY 15, 1962. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purpose aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed 0.185 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NW¼ SW¼, AS PROJECTED WITHIN N. RICHARDSON DLC 63, SECTION 19, T 1 S, R 2 W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
