CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

RALPH A. WITHYCOMB  
HILLSBORO, OR 97123

confirms the right to use the water of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of the TUALATIN RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 14.8 ACRES.

The right was perfected under Permit No. 27858 and the date of priority is FEBRUARY 15, 1962. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purpose aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed 0.185 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , AS PROJECTED WITHIN N. RICHARDSON DLC 63, SECTION 19, T 1 S, R 2 W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent, for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  14.0 ACRES  
SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$  0.8 ACRES  
BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN N. RICHARDSON DLC 63  
SECTION 19

TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 2 WEST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 31925, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAR 22 1999, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
