## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KAUER BROTHERS ROUTE 1, BOX 62 B HILLSBORO, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of STOREY CREEK, a tributary of WAIBLE CREEK, for the IRRIGATION of 17.05 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 21062. The date of priority is JANUARY 28, 1952. The right is limited to 0.21 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located within Lot 3 (NW1/4 SE1/4), SECTION 17, T 1 N, R 2 W, WM.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
