CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

Z X RANCH

PAISLEY, OREGON 97636

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS 4, 5, AND 6 in the SILVER LAKE BASIN for PRIMARY IRRIGATION OF 302.81 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 84.97 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6670. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1974. This right is limited to 4.86 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 1.62 CFS FROM EACH WELL, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

WELL 4 - SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 26 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 1341 FEET SOUTH AND 1395 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 29;

WELL 5 - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 26 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 3977 FEET SOUTH AND 1307.6 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 29; and

WELL 6 - SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, T 28 S, R 15 E, W.M.; 1303 FEET NORTH AND 1349.5 FEET WEST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. This portion of this right for supplemental irrigation is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original points of appropriation.

The well at the new point of appropriation shall be maintained to the well construction standards in effect as of May 10, 1991, and must include an access port.

When required by the Department the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable devices for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.


Water shall be acquired from the same aquifer as the original point of appropriation.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION AND PLACE OF USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 10, 1991, and together with Certificates 76038 AND 76040, supersedes Certificate 50754, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
