CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OREGON DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE
2501 SW 1ST AVENUE
PORTLAND, OREGON 97201

confirms the right to use the waters of GOLD CREEK, a tributary of TRASK RIVER, for FISH HATCHERY.

This right was perfected under Permit 6961. The date of priority is JANUARY 23, 1923. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.995 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

Lot 4 (SW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 8 WEST, W.M.;
845 FEET NORTH AND 265 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Lot 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4)
SECTION 1
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 9 WEST, W.M.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a head gate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the head gate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered January 7, 1997, and together with Certificate 73649, supersedes Certificate 7730, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
