CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That **MOLALLA IRRIGATION COMPANY**, a corporation of **Molalla**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **Molalla River** a tributary of **Willamette River** for the purpose of **Irrigation** under Permit No. **204** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **December 8, 1909**;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **9.26 cubic feet per second**;

The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where the water is put to beneficial use), is as follows: **5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 29 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 6 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 20 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 36 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 18 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 7 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 1 acre in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 21 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 36 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$; 40 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 33; 16 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 30 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 34; Township 4 South, Range 2 East: 6 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 7 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 40 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 20 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 25.6 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 37.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 40 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 39 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$; 36 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and 14 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3; 40 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 24 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 38 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ and 9 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 4; 29 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$; 34 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$; 21 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, and 25 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 10; Township 5 South, Range 2 East of Willamette Meridian, in Clackamas County, containing in all 748 acres of land.**

(NOTE: This Certificate is to correct and supersede that certain Water Right Certificate issued on November 15th, 1922, which certificate was recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates Volume 5, Page 3863.)

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
