CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE WITHERS

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM, a tributary of WOLF CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD LIMITED TO HUMAN CONSUMPTION DURING THE PERIOD JUNE 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30 OF EACH YEAR.

This right was perfected under Permit 52595. The date of priority is JUNE 3, 1992. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND(CFS) DURING THE PERIOD OF DECEMBER 1 THROUGH MAY 31 AND 0.005 CFS DURING THE PERIOD OF JUNE 1 THROUGH NOVEMBER 30 OF EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; SOUTH 0 DEGREES 9 MINUTES WEST 43.2 FEET AND NORTH 89 DEGREES 51 MINUTES WEST 34.6 FEET FROM THE SE CORNER OF THE NE 1/4 NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.


The water user may be required to install, maintain, and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion as required by Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
