CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of the DESCHUTES RIVER, to maintain instream flow for FISHERIES ENHANCEMENT.

These rights were confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 433. The date of priority is 1885.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the original point of diversion from the source, during the period from MARCH 1 to OCTOBER 31, of each year.

The original point of diversion is located as follows:

SMITH DITCH, NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 9, T 15 S, R 10 E, WM.

A description of the stream reaches to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion, Smith Ditch, in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 9, T 15 S, R 10 E, WM, to the confluence with Indian Ford Creek in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 3, T 13 S, R 12 E, WM; and, from the confluence of Indian Ford Creek to the mouth in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 7, T 13 S, R 12 E, WM.

This instream right shall replace a portion of the existing instream water rights for Squaw Creek, evidenced by Certificates 73223 and 73224, during the period from March 1 to October 31, of each year.

This Certificate is issued to confirm changes in use and places of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 8180, and together with Certificate 76112, supersedes Certificate 75840, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use in the place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
