CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LOYALTA INC., LOY M. GOSSLER, PRES.  
ROUTE 3, BOX 3268  
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL #2 in the UMATILLA RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 158.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-2291. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 7, 1962. This right is limited to not more than 1.13 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND; if available at the original point of diversion in the NW1/4 NE1/4, Section 29, T4N, R29E, WM; Well #1 - 1280 feet South and 2620 feet West from NE corner Section 29, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 29, T 4 N, R 29 E, W.M.; 1050 FEET NORTH AND 640 FEET WEST FROM CENTER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein for supplemental irrigation shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

This certificate is issued to confirm a diminution to supplemental irrigation and to correctly describe the place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered June 11, 1999, and supersedes Certificate 55324, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
