CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOHN F. WALCHLI  
ROUTE 3, BOX 3342  
HERMISTON, OREGON 97838

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED STREAM and WALCHLI RESERVOIR constructed under Permits R-6575 and R-8362, a tributary of COLUMBIA RIVER, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 37.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50210. The date of priority is MARCH 9, 1987. This right is limited to not more than 0.94 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversions are located as follows:

Unnamed Stream - SW  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 4, T 4 N, R 29 E, W.M.;  
1040 FEET NORTH AND 1540 FEET WEST FROM THE E  $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER, SECTION 4.  
Reservoir - NE  $\frac{1}{4}$  NE  $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 4, T 4 N, R 29 E, W.M.;  
1180 FEET SOUTH AND 580 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 4.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from Walchli Reservoir, provided further that the right allowed herein for supplemental irrigation shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  SE  $\frac{1}{4}$  SECTION 8  
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.  
SUPPLEMENTAL  
37.7 Acres

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
