CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DOROTHY SAARINEN  
19845 SW STAFFORD ROAD  
WEST LINN, OREGON 97068

confirms the right to use the waters of TUALATIN RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.03 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 23350. The date of priority is DECEMBER 28, 1954. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.; NORTH 32 DEGREES 25 MINUTES EAST 1851 FEET FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.63 ACRE  
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 0.40 ACRE  
SECTION 21  
TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a head gate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the head gate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered February 1, 1996, and along with Certificate 76145 correcting remaining right Certificate 68693, supersedes Certificate 23125, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
