CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BUTTE CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, to maintain instream flow for FISHERIES ENHANCEMENT.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for JACKSON County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 14, at Page 498. The date of priority is 1895.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion: NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 13, T 36 S, R 1 E, WM; 520 FEET SOUTH AND 3215 FEET WEST FROM THE E $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER, SECTION 13; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source, during the period from APRIL 1 TO OCTOBER 1, of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 14, T 36 S, R 1 E, WM; 70 FEET SOUTH AND 2110 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 14.

A description of the stream reach to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

From the authorized point of diversion, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 14, T 36 S, R 1 E, WM; 70 FEET SOUTH AND 2110 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 14, to the mouth, in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 13, T 36 S, R 2 W, WM, with a priority date of 1895.

This instream right shall replace portions of the existing instream water rights for Little Butte Creek, evidenced by Certificates 59818 and 59820, during the period from April 1 to October 1, of each year.

This certificate is issued to confirm changes in use and place of use approved by an order of the Water Resources Director approving Transfer 8073, and together with Certificate 76148, supersedes Certificate 48247, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
