CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H.M. BUTLER
REDMOND, OREGON 97756

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK, a tributary of DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 15.7 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 471. The date of priority is 1901.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.314 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

McCALLISTER DITCH - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 29, T 15 S, R 10 E, W.M.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:


SE 1/4 NE 1/4 15.2 ACRES
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.5 ACRE
SECTION 7
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE PLACE OF USE AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 63799.

The issuance of this certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
