## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

STEVEN L. & MARY McBRIDE P.O. BOX 92 JAMIESON, OREGON 97909

confirms the right to use the waters of MCBRIDE WELL # 1, a tributary of WILLOW CREEK for IRRIGATION and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 205.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-1366 with a date of priority of April 29, 1959.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.56 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or the equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

MCBRIDE WELL #1 - SW% SW%, Section 3, Township 16 South, Range 43 East, W. M.; 233 feet North and 232 feet East from the SW corner, Section 3.

The amount of water used for supplemental irrigation, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or the equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
