CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JESSE C. SCOTT BEULAH, OREGON 97911

confirms the right to use the waters of JERRY CREEK, a tributary of MALHEUR RIVER for IRRIGATION OF 26.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at Page 228. The date of priority is 1890.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a total of 1.30 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or the equivalent in case of rotation.

The points of diversion are identified as follows:

ARNOLD #1 & #2

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to: a diversion of 1.5 ACRE FEET per acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1st of each year, a diversion of 1.0 ACRE FOOT per acre in any 30 day period after June 1st of each year, or a total diversion of 3.0 ACRE FEET per acre during the irrigation season of each year, and at a rate not to exceed ONE-TWENTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or the equivalent, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 7008, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on November 4, 2002, and recorded in Special Order Volume 56, Page 2004, approving a petition by the Vale Oregon Irrigation District under ORS 541.329.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said permit.
