## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

VALE OREGON IRRIGATION DISTRICT 521 "A" STREET WEST VALE, OREGON 97918

confirms the right to use the waters of BULLY CREEK, a tributary of MALHEUR RIVER for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 241.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Malheur County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at Page 228. The dates of priority are 1886 for Tract 1, 1897 for Tract 2, and October 21, 1903 for Tract 3.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a total of 12.05 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the Johnson Ditch - SW¼ SE¼, Section 2, Township 18 South, Range 43 East, W.M.; and Jensen Ditch - NW¼ SE¼, Section 19, Township 18 South, Range 43 East, W.M.; 1350 feet West and 1320 feet North from the SE Corner of Section 19, or the equivalent in case of rotation.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

LATERAL 197-13 - SW% SE%, Section 12, Township 18 South, Range 43 East, W.M.; 878 feet North and 2847 feet East from the SW corner of Section 12.

LATERAL 196 - NW% SW%, Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 44 East, W.M.; 2065 feet North and 764 feet East from the SE Corner of Section 18.

NE% SE%, Section 32, Township 18 South, Range 44 East, W.M.; 663 feet South and 282 feet West from the NE Corner of Section 32.

The amount of water used for supplemental irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of 1.5 ACRE FEET per acre in any 30 day period prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>, 1.0 ACRE FOOT per acre in any 30 day period after June 1<sup>st</sup>, of each year, or 3.0 ACRE FEET per acre during any season,

diverted at a rate not to exceed ONE-TWENTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate confirms an order of the director entered on November 4, 2002 and recorded in Special Order Volume 56, Page 2004, approving a petition by Vale Oregon Irrigation District under ORS 541.329 for mapping water rights within a district. This certificate also confirms orders of the director approving Transfers 7721 and 7835 entered September 7, 1999, and recorded at Special Order Volume 53, Pages 1201 and 1205 respectively; and an order of the director approving Transfer 7368 entered December 19, 1997, and recorded at Special Order Volume 51, Page 1369. This certificate supersedes Certificate 6936.

The right to the use of the water for the above purposes is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
