## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of A SUMP, a tributary of WILLOW CREEK for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 327.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-8702 with a date of priority of November 5, 1979.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 4.09 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, if available at the authorized point of diversion, or the equivalent in case of rotation.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SUMP - NW% NE%, Section 23, Township 17 South, Range 44 East, W.M.; 60 feet South and 1440 feet West from the NE corner of Section 23.

The amount of water used for supplemental irrigation, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or the equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
