CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MS. MARILYN YOUNG 1379 PONDEROSA DRIVE ASHLAND, OREGON 97520

confirms the right to use the waters of LOUSE CREEK, a tributary of JUMP-OFF-JOE CREEK, for MAINTENANCE OF THREE FISH PONDS CONSTRUCTED UNDER APPLICATION NO. R-30176, PERMIT NO. R-1792.

This right was perfected under Permit 23807. The date of priority is AUGUST 8, 1955. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.2 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

ORIGINAL POD - SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 760 FEET NORTH AND 250 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21; AND

ADDITIONAL POD - SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 513 FEET NORTH AND 948 FEET WEST FROM THE SOUTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 SECTION 21 TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion together with that diverted at the old point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water lawfully available at the original point of diversion.

The water user shall maintain a head gate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the head gate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 15, 1997, and supersedes Certificate 26864, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
