## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

JOE BOCHSLER 1840 WILCO HIGHWAY MT. ANGEL, OREGON 97362

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the ZOLLNER CREEK (PUDDING RIVER) BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 70.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-3730. The date of priority is JUNE 22, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.55 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the wells.

The wells are located as follows:

OLD WELL - NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 1500 FEET NORTH AND 130 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 35; AND

NEW WELL - SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 1170 FEET NORTH AND 450 FEET WEST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 35.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 9.8 ACRES

SECTION 35

TOWNSHIP 5 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.

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The quantity of water diverted at the new point of appropriation (well), together with the quantity of water diverted at the original point of appropriation, shall not exceed the quantity of water available from the original point of appropriation.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install an in-line flow meter or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water used. The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered MAY 22, 1992, and supersedes Certificate 42309, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
