CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROBERT N. CAMERON

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.7 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 12340. The date of priority is AUGUST 31, 1936. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.008 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), SECTION 15, T 26 S, R 4 W, W.M.; 550 FEET SOUTH AND 620 FEET WEST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$ CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.3 ACRE
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.4 ACRE
ALL AS PROJECTED WITHIN HUNTLEY DLC 38
SECTION 15
TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 7, 1995, approving Transfer 6830, and describes that portion of the water right NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 26 1999 approving Transfer Application 7405.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
