CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WAYNE AND JUDY GUILLEN  
95179 SIXES RIVER ROAD  
SIXES, OREGON, 97476

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.0 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 51819. The date of priority is DECEMBER 23, 1991. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.013 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 23, T 26 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 680 FEET SOUTH AND 2020 FEET WEST FROM THE N $\frac{1}{4}$  CORNER OF SECTION 23.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SECTION 23

TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the water user to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the director notifies the water user to install a meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.

- B. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under this right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The water user shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion. The required screens and by-pass devices are to be in place, functional and approved by an ODFW representative prior to diversion of any water.

The water user shall not construct, operate or maintain any dam or artificial obstruction to fish passage in the channel of the subject stream.

This certificate correctly describes that portion of the water right perfected under Permit 51819, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 30 1999, approving Transfer Application 8113, and supercedes Certificate 76245, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best possible technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
