CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the BIRCH CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 136.0 ACRES AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 60.2 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-7967. The date of priority is AUGUST 29, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.521 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW% SE%, SECTION 10, T 1 N, R 32 E, W.M.; 820 FEET NORTH AND 410 FEET EAST FROM THE S% CORNER, SECTION 10.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 ACRE-FEET per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.
