CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

confirms the right to use the waters of AN UNNAMED SPRING, a tributary of NORTH FORK MUNGERS CREEK, for WILDLIFE.

This right was perfected under Permit 45764. The date of priority is APRIL 21, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 25, T 38 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1940 FEET SOUTH AND 530 FEET EAST FROM THE N 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 25.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 25  
TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
