confirms the right to store the waters of SODA CREEK, a tributary of JENNY CREEK, to be maintained under Permit 48171, for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-9256. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 23, 1983. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 0.06 acre-foot.

The reservoir is located as follows:


SE 1/4 NW 1/4

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe or the provision of other means to evacuate the stored water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE SECONDARY PERMIT AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 63205.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
