CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DENNIS MARSH

GLADSTONE, OREGON 97027

confirms the right to use the waters of a WELL in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 278.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-9555. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 3, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.48 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 4 S, R 14 E, WM; 1850 FEET SOUTH AND 1040 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

This certificate is issued in accordance with OAR 690-15-090 to confirm the water right for a non-completed change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered March 31, 1997, at Special Order Volume 51, Page 341, approving Transfer 7358, and supersedes Certificate 57568, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
