CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

E. T. SLAYTON PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of OCHOCO CREEK, a tributary of THE CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 231.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1873.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.89 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FOR IRRIGATION and a reasonable amount for domestic and stock use or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

COMBS AND SLAYTON DITCH.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
