CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

LES GILMAN
2857 OAKRIDGE AVENUE
CENTRAL POINT, OREGON 97502

confirms the right to use the waters of ROGUE RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATING 6.17 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 23796. The date of priority is JULY 28, 1955. This right is limited to 0.08 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 13, TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.; 20 FEET NORTH AND 610 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 4.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4 6.17 ACRES
SECTION 13
TOWNSHIP 36 SOUTH, RANGE 3 WEST, W.M.

When in the judgment of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install head gates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled; and


The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 30, 1987, and together with Certificate 57547, supersedes Certificate 52205, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
