CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for UNION COUNTY. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 8, at Page 1. The date of priority is 1900.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed THREE ACRE FEET PER ACRE IN ANY IRRIGATION SEASON, DIVERTED AT A RATE OF NOT TO EXCEED ONE-FORTIETH OF A CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4 NE 1/4 10.0 ACRES SECTION 4 TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

THIS CERTIFICATE IS ISSUED TO CORRECTLY DESCRIBE THE PLACE OF USE AND SUPERSEDES CERTIFICATE 6216 AS STIPULATED BY THE CIRCUIT COURT OF THE STATE OF OREGON FOR UNION COUNTY.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
