CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DEER CREEK, a tributary of the YAMHILL RIVER, for IRRIGATION of 56.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 45983. The date of priority is MAY 1, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.71 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE% SE%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 53, SECTION 30, T 5 S, R 5 W, WM; 1500 FEET NORTH AND 550 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
