CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WILLIAM E. MILLER
110 NE GREENWOOD
BEND, OREGON 97701

confirms the right to use the waters of CITY OF BEND WASTE WATER AND NORTH RIDGE RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-6893, tributaries of TUMALO CREEK, for IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit 42782. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1974. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.6 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

WASTE WATER DIVERSION - SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.; 1014 FEET NORTH AND 174 FEET EAST FROM THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 34; AND

NORTH RIDGE RESERVOIR - NW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-SEVENTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 1/2 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year from direct flow and storage from North Ridge Reservoir constructed under permit R-6893 and shall not carry with it the right to compel the continuance of waste water.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4	0.1 ACRE
SECTION 35	
NE 1/4 NW 1/4	1.8 ACRES
NW 1/4 NW 1/4	15.1 ACRES
SW 1/4 NW 1/4	21.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	3.6 ACRES
SECTION 36	
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.	

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
