CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

H.R. GRAHAM
MILTON-FREEWATER, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of the LITTLE WALLA WALLA RIVER,
for IRRIGATION of 2.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State
of Oregon for UMATILLA County. The decree is of record at Salem, in
the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 12, at
Page 9. The date of priority is 1871.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed ONE AND ONE-
HALF MINER'S INCHES PER ACRE or its equivalent in case of rotation,
measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 2, T 5 N, R 35 E, WM; 380 FEET SOUTH AND
740 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 2.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant
is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 2.0 ACRES
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 6 NORTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed
by Certificate 33257, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT
modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director
entered NOV 8 1999, approving Transfer Application
7640.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the
status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610
pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted
to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is
subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said
decree.
