CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DESCHUTES VALLEY FARMS PO BOX 166 CULVER, OREGON 97734

confirms the right to use the waters of DEEP CANYON CREEK, a tributary of THE DESCHUTES RIVER, for IRRIGATING 157.1 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 32049. The date of priority is APRIL 13, 1967. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.81 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW½ SE½, SECTION 9, T. 14 S., R. 12 E., W.M.; 4440 FEET SOUTH AND 3020 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 9.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
