CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DESCHUTES VALLEY FARMS, INC. CULVER, OREGON 97734

confirms the right to use the waters of TWO WELLS in the DESCHUTES RIVER BASIN for IRRIGATION of 232.8 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 80.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4396. The date of priority is APRIL 15, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.91 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, being 0.26 cfs from Well 1, 1.48 cfs from Well 2, and 2.17 cfs from Well 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 18, T 14 S, R 12 E, WM; WELL 1 - 1050 FEET NORTH AND 6980 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 17;

NW¼ SW¼, SECTION 19, T 14 S, R 12 E, WM; WELL 2 - 2390 FEET NORTH AND 4420 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 19; and,

NE% NE%, SECTION 35, T 14 S, R 11 E, WM; WELL 3 - 5520 FEET SOUTH AND 770 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
