CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DESCHUTES VALLEY FARMS, INC. REDMOND, OREGON 97756

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL 2 in the DEEP CANYON BASIN for IRRIGATION of 164.7 ACRES and SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION of 3.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4974. The date of priority is MARCH 13, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.10 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 19, T 14 S, R 12 E, WM; 2380 FEET NORTH AND 4420 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
