CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GORDON AND CHRISTINE WELLS
268 PICKETT CREEK ROAD
GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97527

confirms the right to use the waters of PICKETT CREEK, a tributary of the ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.75 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 21155. The date of priority is MARCH 4, 1952. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.022 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SECTION 26, T 35 S, R 7 W, W.M.; 500 FEET EAST AND 720 FEET NORTH FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ 1.75 ACRES
SECTION 26
TOWNSHIP 35 SOUTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall install and maintain a fish screen or fish by-pass device. The type and plans of the screen or by-pass device must be approved by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife prior to beginning of construction and shall be installed under the supervision of the Department of Fish and Wildlife.

This certificate is issued to confirm a historic change in point of diversion approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 12 2000, and together with Certificate 76375, supersedes Certificate 21013, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
