## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

DAVE P. UNRUH 6534 TUNNEL LOOP ROAD GRANTS PASS, OREGON 97526

confirms the right to use the waters of ONE WELL in the BUMMER CREEK BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 11.8 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-10295. The date of priority is JUNE 24, 1977. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.15 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 28, T 34 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 1865 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 1.7 ACRES
NW 1/4 NE 1/4 0.3 ACRE
SW 1/4 NE 1/4 5.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 4.4 ACRES
SECTION 28
TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

This use may be regulated if analysis of data available discloses that the appropriation will measurably reduce the surface water flows necessary to maintain the free-flowing character of a scenic waterway in quantities necessary for recreation, fish and wildlife in effect as of the priority date of this right or as those quantities may be subsequently reduced.

The water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of groundwater withdrawn.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
