CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of the NEHALEM RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for DOMESTIC AND RECREATIONAL USE INCLUDING LODGE, CABINS, AND DOMESTIC USE IN A RECREATIONAL CAMPGROUND.

This right was perfected under Permit 46401. The date of priority is DECEMBER 24, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, BEING 0.04 CFS FOR DOMESTIC USE AND 0.01 CFS FOR RECREATION USE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 17 (NW¼ SE¼), SECTION 4, T 4 N, R 7 W, W.M.; 1380 FEET NORTH AND 870 FEET EAST FROM THE S¼ CORNER OF SECTION 4.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 17 (NW ¼ SE ¼)
SECTION 4
TOWNSHIP 4 NORTH, RANGE 7 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
