CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

McKENZIE RIVER GOLF COURSE, INC.
P.O. BOX 98
WALTERVILLE, OREGON 97489

confirms the right to use the waters of HAUGEN CREEK, a tributary of McKENZIE RIVER, for IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit 51229. The date of priority is APRIL 3, 1990. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.58 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 6 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 17, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.;
1539 FEET NORTH AND 1284 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 17.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 7 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)	15.2 ACRES
LOT 6 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4)	17.3 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4	8.4 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4	0.3 ACRE
LOT 8 (NW 1/4 SE 1/4)	0.2 ACRE
SECTION 17	
LOT 3 (NE 1/4 SE 1/4)	0.1 ACRE
LOT 3 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4)	5.0 ACRES
SECTION 18	
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.	


Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

This right is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
