CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WALTER McEWEN ESTATES P.O. BOX 166 JORDAN VALLEY, OR 97710

confirms the right to use the waters of BROCK WELL #1 in the SILVIES RIVER BASIN for the purpose of IRRIGATION OF 126.5 ACRES.

This right has been perfected under Permit G-7352. The date of priority is AUGUST 18, 1975. This right is limited to 1.58 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 14, T 24 S, R 33 E, W.M.; 1320 FEET NORTH AND 1370 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 14.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) and 3.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

This right shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under this right, and to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE 1/4 SW 1/4 31.3 ACRES
NW 1/4 SW 1/4 31.6 ACRES
SW 1/4 SW 1/4 31.2 ACRES
SE 1/4 SW 1/4 32.4 ACRES
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 24 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times. When required by the department, the water user shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
