CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MERLE CRANE ROUTE 1, BOX 274 TURNER, OREGON 97392

confirms the right to use the waters of WELLS 1 AND 3 in the NORTH SANTIAM BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 34.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4609. The date of priority is MAY 21, 1969. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.37 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.17 CFS FROM WELL 1 AND 0.20 CFS FROM WELL 3, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The wells are located as follows:

LOT 2(NW% SE%), SECTION 26, T 9 S, R 2 W, W.M.; WELL 1 - 2450 FEET NORTH AND 2000 FEET WEST; WELL 3 - 1630 FEET NORTH AND 2120 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 26.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; and shall be further limited to appropriation of water only to the extent that it does not impair or substantially interfere with existing surface water rights of others.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
