CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GEORGE P. HARGETT C/O LARRY KROPP 30837 NIXON DRIVE HALSEY, OREGON 97348

confirms the right to use the waters of WILLAMETTE BASIN PROJECT RESERVOIRS CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-1625, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for PRIMARY AND SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION.

This right was perfected under Permit 51928. The date of priority is MAY 26, 1992. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 155.0 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER ONLY, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The period of the allowed use under this right is limited to April 1 through September 30 of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 4 WEST, W.M.; 2610 FEET NORTH AND 1840 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year stored water only. This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

A. The water user shall maintain a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.

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- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of Water Service Contract No. 2-07-10-W0940 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user, a copy of which is on file in the records of the Water Resources Department.

The water user shall maintain and operate fish screening and by-pass devices as required by the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to prevent fish from entering the diversion. The required screen is to be in place and functional prior to diversion of water.

In the event of a request for a change in point of diversion, an additional point of diversion or alteration of the diversion facility associated with this authorized diversion, the quantity of water allowed herein, together with any other right, shall not exceed the capacity of the facility at the time of perfection of this right.

Failure to comply with any of the provision of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use, without waste, on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
