CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GARY AND SANDRA NICHOLS
4247 CANYONVILLE RIDDLE ROAD
RIDDLE, OREGON 97469

confirms the right to use the waters of COW CREEK, a tributary of the SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.58 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 5324. The date of priority is JANUARY 4, 1922. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.007 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 24, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 5 WEST, W.M.; 1043 FEET NORTH AND 147 FEET WEST OF THE SOUTHEAST CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation, for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ 0.58 ACRE
SECTION 24
TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.


When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain a head gate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the head gate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUNE 20, 1997, and together with Certificate 74531, supersedes Certificate 6745, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
